Read [I Corinthians 3:9-15](#) together and answer the following questions.

1. What is the foundation that Paul is speaking of in verse 10?
2. In verse 12, Paul lists out two types of building materials. What does the gold, silver and jewels represent and what do the wood, hay and straw represent?
3. Jesus has given us all time, talents and treasure. Discuss how you are using them to further His kingdom here on earth.
4. Is the judgment seat of Christ something to be feared? What is the great loss some will suffer on that day?
5. Parents discuss with your student what you are or are not doing to give God’s work a higher priority in your life.
6. It is said that the key to serving God is to be intentional. Discuss how you have been intentional in serving God.

Read [II Corinthians 5:9-10](#) together and answer the following questions.

1. What did Paul say was his aim or goal in life? Discuss what your goal is for your life.
2. Who did Paul say would appear before the judgment seat of Christ? Is this a time of rewards and rejoicing or a time of punishment and sadness?
3. We will all give a verbal account to Jesus about what we did with what He gave us. With that in mind, if the judgment seat of Christ was tomorrow would you be ready to stand before God and give account? Why or why not?
4. Pray together as a family that God will help you to set the right priorities and to use your time, talents, and treasure in such a way that is pleasing and honoring to Him.
