Read Philippians 4:14-20 together and answer the following questions.

1. Who were the only ones who gave Paul financial help?
2. Whom do we please when we give sacrificially?
3. Whom does Paul say takes care of you and will supply all your needs?
4. Parents, share a time in your life where you gave of your time, talents (your skills and abilities), or treasures (money or material possessions) and the impact it made in your life and the life of the one or ones you gave to.
5. Talk about what a cheerful giver looks like and how we can be one.
6. Discuss the difference between needs and wants.
7. Pray that God would help your family see the needs of those around you this Christmas season.
8. Make a plan as a family to give to someone in need this Christmas season.
