**Developing Godly HABITS**

Read [Philippians 2:12-13](#) together and answer the following questions.

1. In verse 12 Paul states “Work hard to show the results of your salvation”. Discuss what that would look like and how you would do that.
2. Verse 13 states that God is working in you. How does that make you feel to know that God is partnering with you to help you grow to be more like Christ?
3. God helps you want to do the things that please him. And He gives you the power to do these things. Then what is our part in this process?
4. Statistics show that unless you develop godly habits, you will not attend a church when you get into college. God desires us to be more and more like Christ. To do this we must develop spiritual habits that will help us grow as a Christian. Students explain the acronym HABITS to your parent.

H – Hang Time With God

A – Accountability

B – Bible Memorization

I – Involvement in the Church

T – Tithing

S – Study Scripture

5. Pray together as a family and ask God to help you develop consistent HABITS. Commit to Him that you will take responsibility for your personal growth. Thank Him that He is working in you and with you to make you more like Christ every day.
